
Nature is Calling!

Many people visit Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument to get closer to nature, but sometimes nature calls back. With the lack of bathrooms within the Monument, it is difficult to know what to do when you have to go.

Thankfully, there are several ways you can manage your business in a responsible and sustainable manner. It is important to be responsible with your waste disposal to minimize water pollution, transmission of illness, interactions with insects and wildlife, and unpleasant experiences for other visitors.

We recommend always carrying a "toilet kit" which should include a portable waste containment system, like a Wag Bag, which can be purchased at BLM visitor centers, outdoor gear stores, or online, a plastic bag to dispose of toilet paper and used menstruation products, and hand sanitizer. All of this should be double bagged within your car and brought along with you in your hiking pack. Pack out waste products in your toilet kit and dispose of it in a garbage can when available.
